

"Representative Prusak received her Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Northeastern University in Boston where she was born and raised, and her Masters in Nursing from Frontier Nursing Service (Frontier Nursing University). She is an active member of her union, Oregon Nurses Association, and is a family nurse practitioner who currently works serving homebound elderly patients. Prior to this, she was an ambassador for the National Health Service Corps where she was dedicated to serving families in rural areas of the country with limited access to care. Rep Prusak is a pro-choice champion and has spent years working at Planned Parenthood where she provided full-spectrum reproductive health services.
